
Acute Care Donning Observer Checklist

Suspect/Confirmed EVD Cases and/or Care Environment Coveralls with Integrated Hood and Socks

This checklist is designed to assist in ensuring that health care workers (HCWs) are correctly donning Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for suspect/confirmed cases of EVD and their work environment. **Please Note: This is a sample checklist** that may need to be adapted to meet relevant standards of practice and/or specific manufacturer's user instructions for variations of approved PPE. The tool is to be used by a trained observer to guide the HCW in the donning process and verify that all necessary donning steps are performed and in the proper sequence. Any errors are to be corrected immediately to ensure the HCW is protected.

Note: Establish clearly defined zones (e.g., hot, warm, and cold) and protocols to prevent and control secondary contamination during doffing.

Before you begin, instruct the HCW to don point-of-care scrubs and footwear, hydrate, tie back long hair and secure in place and remove personal items such as hand and wrist jewelry. Gather and inspect PPE carefully. Ensure that the correct size is selected and that the PPE is in good sanitary and working condition. Damaged or defective PPE should not be used.



DONNING PPE PROCEDURE

COMMENTS (May include size of PPE)

Perform hand hygiene:

- Use alcohol-based hand rub (ABHR) or soap and water
- Allow hands to dry completely before putting on any PPE



Put on inner gloves

- Extend cuffs as far up arms as possible
 - Adjust and verify proper fit of PPE

Put on single-use (disposable) impermeable coverall (not including hood at this time):



- Select coverall large enough to allow unrestricted freedom of movement
 - Ensure cuffs of inner gloves remain tucked under sleeves
- Sit on clean chair, as needed

Put on impermeable outer footwear and/or foot coverings:



- Select an appropriate layer of outer footwear and/or foot coverings (e.g., water-proof boots, disposable non-slip boot/shoe covers) to wear over the coverall socks for foot protection and/or as an additional barrier to facilitate doffing in the hot zone
- Adjust and verify proper fit of PPE
